SIR,

In returning the Indent for apparatus and Chemicals for the year 1886/87 forwarded with your Memo: No. 549 dated 7th Instant, I have the honour to call your attention to the instructions contained in para 2 of this office Circular No. 89 dated 24th July 1884, and to request that you will be so good as to divide the whole indent in to three parts as therein required. It will be observed that apparatus and Chemicals have been mixed up in one indent contrary to distinct instructions on the subject. Indent for apparatus whether for use in the physical science laboratory or in the Chemical laboratory should be consolidated in one indent to be marked "Part I. Apparatus for laboratory use", Chemicals whether for use in Physical Science laboratory or Chemical laboratory should be divided with reference only to the places of their manufacture, part II relating

to

to articles of Indian manufacture and part III to
those of European manufacture.

The return of the Indent is requested
