Dr. Sadhu showed acts of insubordination also this year by allowing two outsiders to work with him in this laboratory without my information and permission. Indian Council of Medical Research asked him to carry out the research scheme, financed by them under Dr. Sadhu, in consultation with me, which, however, he did not carry out. Dr. Sadhu is physically fit.
