Will you, please, see the attached copy of a letter of complaint against Babu Bhagabat Saran Pandey, Hindi Pandit of Hare School, who is the Secretary of the Sri Sanatan Dharma Vidyalaya, Calcutta, and let <sup>after enquiring from the Headmaster, Hare School,</sup> me know under what conditions he was permitted to accept <sup>Marwari</sup> the post of the Secretary of the <sup>Marwari</sup> School? Did he actually apply for such permission, and has he got permission to act as tutor to the Marwari boys in the Hindu School if he actually is teaching them privately? This is not the first complaint against the Pandit that has been received.

Sir,

We the people of Burrabazar area beg to bring the following to your kind notice.

The Hindi Pandit of Hare School is the Secretary of Sri ~~Santan~~ <sup>a</sup> Dharma Vidyalaya, 4 Ramji Das Pettia Lane. He swindles public money. He does not care to sever his connection from that Vidyalaya in spite of the Head master's warning. He is a mischief maker. He keeps a headmaster who is gaol returned man in ~~Uttarpara~~ Govt. High School case. He signs for Rs 100/ and gets only Rs 60/. The balance of Rs 40/ goes to Secretary.

The Secretary has got nearly 10 boys of that school for private tuition promising them to give them promotion to send them for Matric. 1931. He gets from each boy Rs 30/. He has five tuitions of Hare School boys all Marwari boys, that is why he does not like to be away from that Vidyalaya. He is mischief maker. He has a relation one Mr. Rajanithi Pandey in the school and he is a member in the committee. He has been dismissed from two schools at Calcutta. The Secretary knows that. Because he is his relation he keeps him there. 9 out of 12 teachers are his friends and relatives. Unless the Headmaster is sent out there is no remedy. He is not fit for Headmaster. He told a lie that he was drawing pension and thus got the post. He has 17 boys of Matric. class under his tuition. All unfit boys because they are private tuitions will be sent up for Matric. this year. The Secretary is very mischievous. He influenced the Principal of the Presidency College and the Headmaster through his friends. He is still trying to be a member of the Vidyalaya. His mischief

will be over only if he is transferred on public grounds. If what all is to be established you may call for S<sup>r</sup>g Des-Ogaha, teacher of Sri Maheswari Vidyalaya and Seethala Jagadamba Prasad Acharji, 5 Shama Bai Galle Lane to prove these facts. He is very bad and mischievous. He does injustice to the teachers and he is a money making machine. Discrepancy in the account and in everything. He takes all question papers himself and shows them to his tuition boys. He has asked persons to value Test papers. Such as ~~me~~ not aware of M<sup>atric</sup> Syllabus simply because to favour all his boys in sending for M<sup>atric</sup>.

He sets and corrects private test papers of Inspector's examination. He has made something like Rs 100/ out of that by showing questions. He deceives the boys by saying he is examiner and will help in University examination. He gets tuitions like this. He is a dangerous element. He asks all the teachers to talk to Headmaster of Hare School on his behalf and remains silent. He does not care for Headmaster. He must be removed from Calcutta. Then alone the school will prosper. It is better to write to University for the welfare of the public. Such a mean minded loafer we cannot see anywhere.

He ran away from guard's duty. We expect speedy remedy.

The Pandit had received the permission of the Director of Public Instruction, Bengal to act as Secretary of the Sanatan Dharma Vidyalaya as will appear from a copy of the Director of Public Instruction, Bengal's letter No.10597G, dated the 21st December, 1929, enclosed herewith.

As the Pandit has now definitely resigned the office of the Hony. Secretary of the Sanatan Dharma Vidyalaya, no further investigation seems necessary.
