Sir,

With reference to your confidential circular No. 31-C dated the 21st August 1930, I have the honour to inform you with regard to the All-India Hartal attempted on the 12th November 1930 that the College and Eden Hindu Hostel worked quite as usual. However, in the case of the Hindu and Hare Schools the attendance fell below 66 % i.e. 56.2 % in the case of the former and 60.45 % in the case of the latter. The Headmasters say that the reason for this fall in attendance is that the guardians were reluctant to send out their boys on account of the expected trouble.
