In reply to your letter No. 634/4A-21-1914 dated the 11th January 1915 and previous correspondence on the subject of the proposed acquisition of the land required for the further development of the Presidency College I have the honor to submit herewith an estimate of probable cost of acquisition of the land and to return the plan.

2. About 13 Bighas of land costing approximately Rs. 884000 has been acquired in three instalments for the extension of the Presidency College during 1908-13. The area and the cost are given from my memory. If the exact figures are required they may be submitted in 2 or 3 days as the records and registers in connection with the acquisition of the land are in the Alipore Collectorate.
