Sir,

I have the honour to report that the work of Babu Hriday Govinda Vidhyalankar, Headpandit of this school, is most unsatisfactory. Hriday Babu joined this school on the 15th. March, 1946 and his Annual Confidential Report could not be submitted on the due date for his work could not be judged within such a short time. After Carefully watching his lessons for these months, I now find that he is a hopeless failure in this school. He is absolutely incapable of maintaining discipline in any of the classes, nor is he ^{at all} keen on his work. His retention on the staff of this school will adversely affect the interest of the school. I would very strongly recommend his transfer from this school before the commencement of the new session.

In this connection I beg to suggest that Babu Hrishikesh Bhattacharjee, M.A., Headpandit Barisal Zilla school, may be placed here, for at one time he worked as the Headpandit of this school with great credit.
