DEPARTMENT. I have the honour to invite reference to General Department, letter No. 2645, dated the 29th June 1915 in which Government accepted the resignation tendered by Babu Hriday Chandra Banerjee of his appointment as Superintendent of the Eden Hindu Hostel and sanctioned the appointment of Babu Nibaran Chandra Bhattacharjee, a Professor of the Presidency College as Superintendent of that Hostel on an allowance of Rs. 100/- per month in addition to his own duties with effect from the 5th July 1915.

2. I have now at the instance of the Principal, Presidency College, to point out that the allowance, sanctioned for the Superintendent, is Rs. 125/- a month and not Rs. 100/- as stated ~~xxx~~ in your letter. I therefore, request that Government may be pleased to issue revised orders on the subject as early as practicable.

intention of Government to the payment of an allowance
of Rs. 125/- per mensem in place of an allowance of
Rs. 100/- as stated in Government Order No. 2645, dated
29th June, 1915, with effect from the 5th July, 1915,
to Babu Hibaren Chandra Bhattacharya, a Professor of
the Presidency College (Class VII of the Provincial
Educational Service) who has been appointed to be
Superintendent of the Eden Hindu Hostel in addition to
his own duties. The expenditure will be met from the
provision made for the purpose in the Education Budget
for the current year.

The appointment of Babu
Friday Chandra Banerji as Sapoth. of
the Eden Hindu Hostel on an
allowance of Rs 100/- p. m. was sanctioned
in Secy. of State's Dispatch no 85 (Public)
of the 29.6.06. It does not appear from
the papers put up that the pay of the
post was subsequently increased to Rs 125/-
Possibly the Eden Hindu Hostel itself
is drawing Rs 125/- according to the

scale of remuneration sanctioned by
India for College Hostel experts. If

If this is so, we cannot perhaps
sanction a fixed allowance @ Rs.
125/- for the ~~even~~ ^{even} kind of Hostel Depots.
As the amount of allowance may
vary according to the number of
inmates. This point was not clearly
stated in D.P.G's letter no 315, of the
3.5.15 while submitting the original
proposal reg: the resignation of
Babu Hriday Chandra Banerji & his
Appointment of B.D. Nickerian Chandra
Bhattacharyya in his place. Reference
was rather invited to the order of
1908 in which an allowance
of Rs. 100/- was sanctioned for
the post. In view of revised order
we may perhaps say that Babu
Nickerian Chandra Bhattacharyya (In present capacity)
will draw allowance according to
the scale of remuneration sanctioned
for the Depots of the Hostels etc
